Telepractice Waiver Update

The recently issued Telepractice Waiver is updated to clarify that, during the duration of the declared disaster emergency, <u>telephonic</u> delivery is an acceptable means of service delivery for Telepractice by OASAS programs.

Providers should bill for telepractice services exactly the way they bill for a service provided by other means, with the only addition being the modifier for each type of service. Additional guidance on billing and practice will be forthcoming through a Frequently Asked Questions document.
